UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

POOL

Several things have been accomplished since the pool closed:

- New Landscaping around the pool has been completed

- One of the pool filters had to be replaced

TENNIS COURT

- Re-surfacing of the tennis court is budgeted for 2017 – it will include Pickle Ball lines
- Gate will be secured – again
- A new sign has been installed

ROADS

- Roads are budgeted to be re-sealed in 2017
- Drainage is a continuing problem which continues to be worked

AMBULANCE SERVICE

At the Annual Meeting in February, the Millville Fire Company EMT's Chief Watson, gave a presentation to the members. They want to start a program so that every home has ambulance service. To do this they are asking that each HOA or town in their district collect the membership fee from every homeowner under their jurisdiction. That way they would not have to send out their appeal letter. The HOAs and towns would be responsible to collect the fees from their members. At this time the Bethany Meadows Recreation Association cannot put up the money and then do the billing for this fee.

The Bethany Meadows Executive Council recommends that each homeowner, for their own protection, send back the appeal letter with \$50.00 to insure their family's protection.
